How to reach Mödling/Vienna, Austria

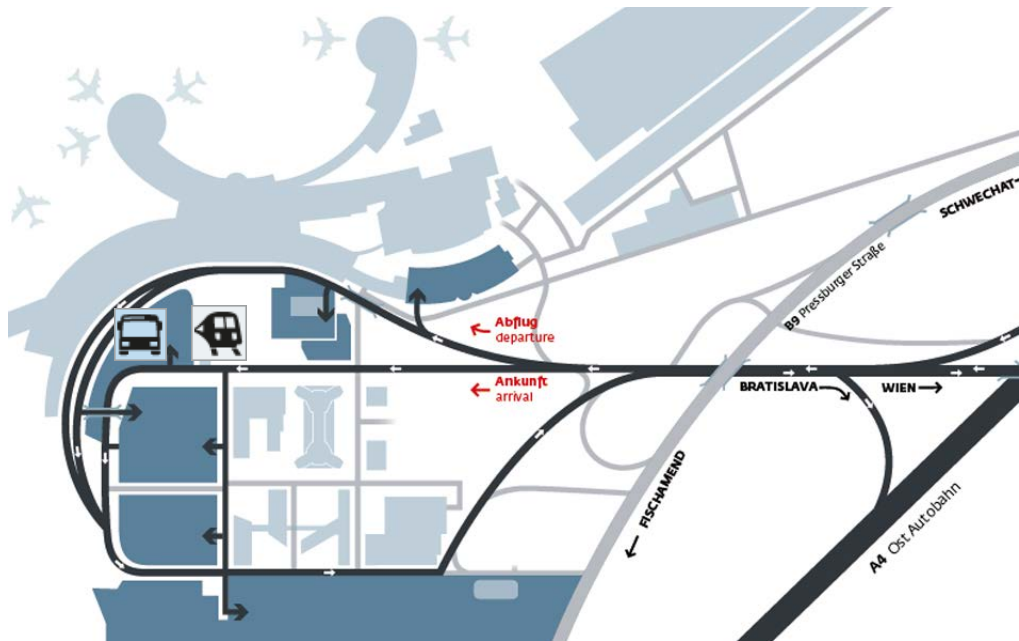
Mödling is only 9 km away from Vienna and close to the airport. It has excellent air, road and train connections.

The nearest airport is Vienna Airport in Schwechat/Vienna.

Vienna Airport Lines (Postbus) connects Vienna Airport with the main Vienna transport hubs. The 3 Vienna Airport Lines routes serve all of Vienna's underground railway lines and also "Wien West" and "Wien Meidling" railway stations. Buses to the city centre (Morzinplatz/Schwedenplatz) run 24 hours a day, journey time just 20 minutes.

Train connections from the airport

The **CAT** takes just 16 minutes nonstop to get from central Vienna to the airport and vice versa. The City Airport Train operates daily from 05.38 a.m. to 23.35 p.m. The City Air Terminal is just 10 minutes from St. Stephan's Cathedral at Wien Mitte station, which can be reached easily by tram, underground, bus or taxi.

The City Airport Train offers a comfortable and relaxing journey in the double-decker carriages with jet environment and first-class seats. During the journey monitors provide interesting background and online information about departures and arrivals.

Price (single): € 12.00

A separate CAT counter is located in the arrivals hall, where you can obtain information about all CAT services, purchase a ticket and much more arrivals and departures.

An alternative is the **S-Bahn S7 Airport Vienna (VIE) - Wien Mitte Floridsdorf** which takes 27 minutes.

Price: € 4

In case you want to go from the airport to Mödling by train you may use the CAT or the S_Bahn S7 to Wien Mitte and switch to S-Bahn S9.

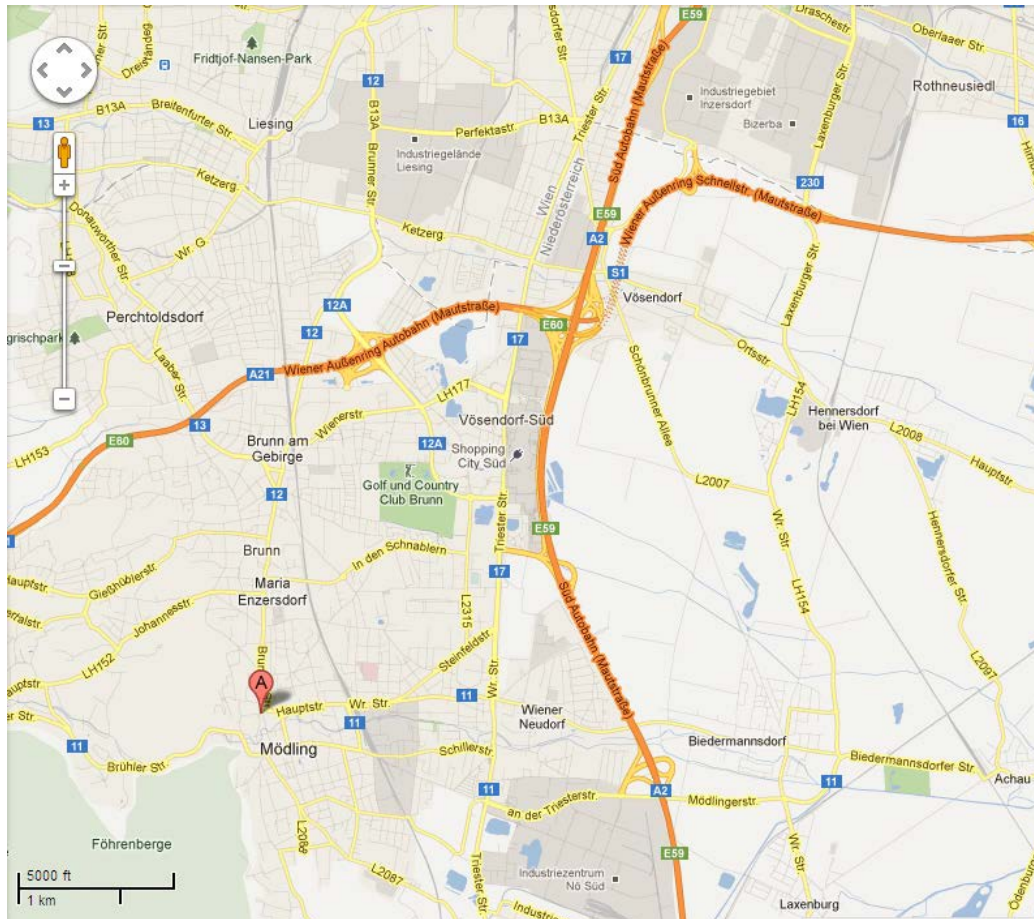

Road Connections from the Airport

A4 Ost Autobahn (from Hungary to A23/Vienna)

B9 Hainburger Bundesstraße

The Airport is located 30,8 km from the centre of Mödling, or 27 minutes by car. You can go to Mödling via B9, Hainburger Bundesstraße (direction Schwechat) - S1 Wiener Außenring Schnellstraße to Knoten Vösendorf - A2 Süd Autobahn. Mödling is located near the A2 Exit Mödling. From there follow the route Triesterstraße, Wienerstraße, Hauptstraße, Badstraße, Babenberggasse and Elisabethstraße (pedestrian zone).
