



## ESOP Project : centers of exchange

### Objectives:

- ✚ To develop and promote education and training of clinical and oncology pharmacy practice among Europe
- ✚ To promote exchange of knowledge, information and excellence activities among our community.
- ✚ To facilitate unification of pharmaceutical activities in respect of specificities and differences of each country

### Principles

- All countries are invited to make their proposals of opportunities for the center of exchanges
- To be a center of exchange, the pharmacy department has to fill a registration form which describes the different pharmaceutical activities in cancer area.
- Pharmacist responsible for the exchange program must be clearly identified (list also associated pharmacists)
- Informations must be available concerning the organisation, schedule of the visit and the practical role of the responsible pharmacist during the stay.
- Pharmaceutical activities (with associated pharmacist) included in the exchange program must be listed

**It is also necessary to select activities that can be considered as reference activities for the exchange program.**

**Practical informations for the stay, including financial aspects (accommodation possibilities) have to be precised.** Pharmacist responsible for the exchange can facilitate these different questions (projected budget)

The question of “practical language” during the stay for all associated pharmacists will be also listed. All associated pharmacists involved in the exchange program need to be fluent in english or in the language of the host.

Proposals and registration forms have to be sent to the ESOP project “center of exchange” officer for validation (definitive validation will be done by ESOP board).

The ESOP officer can ask different complementary informations to the pharmacist responsible for the center of exchange or the national society of oncology pharmacy.

After validation, registration form will be available in the Website of ESOP.
