



European Society of Oncology Pharmacy (ESOP) publication policy

In Europe, data and privacy protection laws apply to all European Union institutions, bodies and agencies. To aid ESOP members and the ESOP society to comply to these laws, the following publication policy has been installed as of September 2019.

- 1) For scientific publications in the European Journal of Oncology Pharmacy (EJOP) detailed instructions on the protection of patient data, the disclosure of potential conflict of interests of authors and the authorships credits can be found on the EJOP website: <https://journals.lww.com/ejop/pages/default.aspx>
All submitted manuscripts must adhere to these guidelines.
- 2) For scientific publications in the form of abstracts submitted for presentation at the European Conference of Oncology Pharmacy (ECOP), detailed guidelines will be published per event at the ESOP website: <https://ecop.events/> All submitted abstracts must adhere to these guidelines.
- 3) For contributions to the monthly newsletter of ESOP, for example reports on national conferences or conferences of Societies that ESOP has a collaboration with, the following rules apply:
 - a. The author must obtain approval from the organising body to write a report on the conference/event.
 - b. The author must obtain approval for the text of the report or contribution from the organising body of the conference/event.
 - c. Photographic material may only be included after written approval of the persons that are recognisable on the photographic material. This written approval should be obtained by the author.
- 4) For contributions to the ESOP website, the same rules apply as for the contributions to the monthly newsletter, but in addition approval by the Board of ESOP must be obtained as well.
