Module 1: Theoretical knowledge

Duration: two days - 6 hours / day

Themes **Module 1:**

1. The safe handling of cytotoxic drugs

8. Workshop: presentation of medical devices, practical exercise: hand washing and handling techniques; infusion kits; medication preparation and administration
