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## Safe handling and storage



- Do not halve or crush tablets, do not open capsules.
- Do not take damaged tablets/capsules.
- Keep out of reach for children.
- Must not be handled by pregnant or breastfeeding persons.
- Handling of body fluids (e.g., vomit): wear disposable gloves for cleaning and discard used wipes and gloves in a closed plastic bag.
- Storage:  Room temperature (max. 25°C)  
 Fridge (2-8°C)
